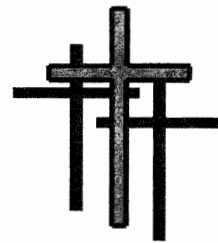
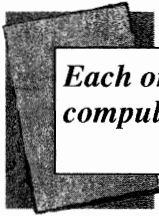


2005 St. Bartholomew's Pledge Card
